ALHAMBRA



Alhambra possesses a relatively dry, low-humidity climate averaging about 18 inches of rain a year. The coldest month average temperature is 55 degrees, and the hottest month average temperature is 78 degrees.




The California Native Plant Society is a great resource to help you plant waterwise California Native vegetation at your home, business, school or other location. Their Garden Planner "tool" is an easy process to help you identify common and readily available plants suited to your location.


Visit **gardenplanner.calscape.org** and, when prompted, enter the following information:

- (1) the city in which you live
- (2) the style of garden you desire
- (3) the amount of sun on your property
- (4) your goal of water conservation

The "Planner" generates a wide variety of categories and pictures of waterwise, California Native vegetation: trees, shrubs, perennials, annuals, grasses and more, as well as plants suited to different light and moisture conditions. Within each category there are dozens of recommended plants and instructions for prep, planting, watering, fertilizing, pruning and seeding. You may view, download and print the information.
